


TRANSPACIFIC TRADE AFTER COVID-19


In the first half of this year, China's total exports across the Pacific reached 11.46 trillion yuan, and the scale of foreign trade imports and exports surpassed 20 trillion yuan for the first time in history during the same period. Additionally, domestic flight volume in the first half of the year has already exceeded pre-pandemic levels.


















Post-pandemic Major Transpacific Export Types in Laborintensive Products



SHANGHAI

In H1 2023, Shanghai's export volume reached 846.32 billion yuan, with a 15.2% YoY growth. The city's import increased by an average of 2.6% over the past two years. Private enterprises played a significant role, contributing 51.1% to the overall foreign trade growth. Trade with the EU grew by 16.2%, outpacing the overall rate. Electromechanical products dominated exports, accounting for 69.7% of the total, with significant growth in "new three items" like electric vehicles and lithium batteries.

SHENZHEN


In the first half of 2023, Shenzhen's out-material processing trade exhibited robust performance, with export value in June showing a remarkable year-on-year growth of 2830.9%. The total export value from January to June reached 420 million yuan, which is seven times higher than the entire export value of the previous year.



QINGDAO

In H1 2023, Qingdao's foreign trade export value was 232.42 billion yuan, with a 3.5% YoY growth. In June, the import and export value surged to 80.8 billion yuan, with exports growing by 18.3%. ASEAN was the main trading partner, with a trade value of 83.01 billion yuan, up 29.3% accounting for 19.3% of the total

2016 was a busy year for ransomware. Some samples targeted critical infrastructure, while others went after rivalling cryptomalware families. Some adopted new techniques to prey upon users, whereas others went offline entirely. Ransomware took in about \$1 billion in 2016, based on money coming into ransomware-related Bitcoin wallets. Hackers were indiscriminate in choosing their victims, targeting large cooperations, SMEs as well as individuals. Eric delivered a cybersecurity solution to protect company networks and data from the ransomware DMA Locker attack.

In 2017, to streamline logistics processes and reduce time-consuming manual work, CargoWise One (CW1) project was initiated and implemented successfully. CW1 is a centralized logistics operations on a single global database with strong real-time data visibility, workflow automation, flexible and comprehensive integrations. It strengthens business continuity via its global disaster recovery capability, data management, upgrades and maintenance, backup, and continuity planning.

To enhance collaborative communication, streamline work and save time, a cloud-based business communication platform was built with integrated messaging, calls, and video communications to connect workflow with communication and avoid any disconnect.

In 2020, the COVID-19 pandemic accelerated existing trends in remote work. The remote workforce solution was deployed, enabling staff to do their jobs from home or elsewhere from secured IT environment. To maintain a high level of productivity and business continuity during the lockdowns in Chinese cities.
